

Holy Places in Unholy Times

V pátek 30. 5. 2025 se v prostorách Kampusu Hybernská uskutečnil kulatý stůl na téma *Holy Places in Unholy Times*. Moderátorky Ivana Noble a Kateřina Kočandrle Bauer si do mezinárodního a mezináboženského panelu pozvaly Anne-Marie Reijnen (Paříž), Saidu Mirsadri (Bonn), sestru Marii Farouza Maximos (Jeruzalém) a Sylvii Wittmannovou (Praha). Řečnice zkoumaly zdroje svatosti, její ambivalentní charakter i způsoby, jak vnášet prvky svatosti do každodenního života.

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On Friday, May 30, 2025, a round table on the topic of “Holy Places in Unholy Times” took place at the Hybernská Campus. Moderators Ivana Noble and Katerina Kočandrle Bauer invited Anne-Marie Reijnen (Paris), Saida Mirsadri (Bonn), Sister Maria Farouza Maximos (Jerusalem) and Sylvia Wittmann (Prague) to join the international and interfaith panel. The speakers explored the sources of holiness, its ambivalent nature and ways of bringing elements of holiness into everyday life.
